

# 2019 Holy Days of Obligation

Holy Days of Obligation vary from year to year because the precept to attend Mass is abrogated if any of the following Holy Days fall on a Saturday or on a Monday the precept to attend mass is abrogated.

***January 1, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God***

***August 15, the Solemnity of the Assumption***

***November 1, the Solemnity of All Saints***

**Tuesday, January 1, 2019 – Solemnity – Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God**

*Is a Holy Day of Obligation*

**Thursday, May 30, 2019 – Ascension of Jesus**

*The Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord is transferred to the Seventh Sunday of Easter, Sunday, June 2, 2019*

**Thursday, August 15, 2019 – The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary**

*Is a Holy Day of Obligation*

**Friday, November 1, 2019 – All Saints Day**

*Is a Holy Day of Obligation*

**Monday, December 9, 2019 – The Immaculate Conception**

*Because the solemnity falls on the Second Sunday of Advent, this solemnity is transferred to the following day, the obligation to attend Mass is abrogated.*

**Wednesday, December 25, 2019 – Christmas**

*Is a Holy Day of Obligation*
