Part-Time Spanish Teacher

St. Viator Parish School is now accepting applications for a qualified Spanish for the 2021-2022 school year. This is a part-time position with flexible hours. Students in K – 5 receive instruction 30 minutes per week. Students in grades 6-8 receive 50 minutes twice a week.

- Spanish classes shall introduce students to the Spanish language and prepare them for further study in order to become linguistically and culturally equipped to communicate successfully.
- The expectation is that this be achieved through four main communication objectives: speaking, listening, writing and reading. More specifically, Spanish culture, basic conversational terms/skills (including food, family, clothing, school, sports, activities, and friendships, etc.); to hold a basic conversation in Spanish and communicate basics such as their name, age, likes, dislikes, etc.
- As students advance, classes will review of the previous year's material and students should be exposed to listening to more of the Spanish language and should also be expected to speak more of the language, including conversational subjects such as: home life, health, community, environment, ordering in restaurants, leisure, vacation times, etc.

Preferred qualifications include: previous experience in elementary school instruction, demonstrated experience of strong classroom management skills, excellent verbal and written communication skills, and strong knowledge of curriculum.
